PROSPECTUS FOR GNM

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FOR ADMISSION TO DIPLOMA IN GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY COURSE – 2026 ADMISSION

1. TRUST :

Moulana Charitable Trust, Moulana Hospital, Perinthalmanna, Malappuram District.

2. HOSPITAL :

College of Nursing-Moulana Hospital (GNM Division) is attached to Moulana Super Speciality Hospital, 300 bedded Multi Super Speciality Hospital situated in Perinthalmanna, Malappuram District, 679322.

3. PHILOSOPHY :

College of Nursing-Moulana Hospital, mainly focus to prepare excellent health care provided and leaders to transform the lives of individuals and Community through innovative, education and health care. An awareness of ethical and spiritual values is an essential component of educational efforts.

The Nursing programme explores a differentiated practice model that teaches students to maximize their own role development to seek opportunity to learn and collaborate effectively to other nurse of differing educational preparation.

The programmes integrate holistic health care values with traditional health care values. So, students can explore the understanding of “Whole body wellness” in client care.

4. GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

- 1) The candidate on completion of this course will be able to :
 - a. Assess the nursing need of clients from birth to death.
 - b. Plan and carry out appropriate action to meet nursing needs.
 - c. Provide effective nursing care to maintain best possible level of health in all aspects.
 - d. Promote self care in people under their care.
 - e. Apply problem solving techniques in nursing practice.
 - f. Evaluate effectiveness of nursing care.
- 2) Apply knowledge from the humanities, biological and behavioral sciences in functioning as a nurse.
- 3) Function effectively with members of the health team and community applying the knowledge of human relations and communication skill in work.
- 4) Participate as member of the health team in delivery of curative, preventive, promotive and rehabilitative health care services.
- 5) Demonstrate use of ethical values in their personal and professional life.
- 6) Demonstrate interest in activities of professional organization.
- 7) Recognize the need for continuing education for professional development.
- 8) Demonstrate basic skills in teaching patients and giving nursing care to them.
- 9) Demonstrate basic skills in administration and leadership while working with other members of health team and community.
- 10) Assist in research activities.

5. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO GNM PROGRAMME – 2026-27 :

Candidates :

1. Minimum age of admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December 2026.
2. There will be no maximum / upper age limit for admission.

3. 10, +2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Science group with Physics, Chemistry, Biology is preferable. In the absence candidates with science group, candidates with other groups also will be considered.
4. Eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government.
5. Registered ANM with pass mark.
6. Candidates who have passed 10, +2 Health Care Science – Vocational stream from a recognized CBSE board / state / Centre are also eligible for application.

6. DURATION OF THE COURSE :

Duration of the Diploma Course in General Nursing and Midwifery shall be 3 years. The maximum period allowed to complete General Nursing and Midwifery course is 6 years.

7. SYLLABUS :

Syllabus of the course shall be the revised General Nursing and Midwifery Syllabus 2015 of the Indian Nursing Council.

8. NO. OF SEATS :

The total number of the seats to General Nursing and Midwifery course is 40.

9. APPLICATION FORM :

Application form for admission to the course will be available at www.minpsnursing.com .

10.DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE ONLINE APPLICATION ARE :

- a) Self attested copy of the relevant page of SSLC or equivalent certificate to prove the date of birth.
- b) Self attested copies of Marks lists of all parts of Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination and pass certificate in the qualifying examination.
- c) Equivalency certificate from Higher Secondary Board, Kerala for candidate who have completed qualifying examination from outside Kerala State.
- d) Copy of recent Conduct Certificate (not prior to six months) from the Head of the Institution in which the candidate studied last.
- e) Any other certificate to prove educational qualification if any required.

11.HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY

Candidate must submit their applications ONLINE, alongwith the necessary supporting documents. The ONLINE facility is available at www.minpsnursing.com . Submission of more than one application by a candidate will result in the rejection of application. Last date of submission of application will be as per paper Notification. Defective application will be rejected.

12.MODE OF ADMISSION :

Admission to Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery will be made on merit as per guidelines issued by the Govt. of Kerala / Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council and Indian Nursing Council. If the number of valid applications are more than the number of sanctioned intake, waiting list will be prepared and if number of valid applications are less than the sanctioned intake, the vacant seats will be filled up by spot admission if necessary, before the last date of admission notified by INC.

13. SELECTION

Candidate will be called for interview and certificate verification by selection committee and selected candidates list will be prepared by the committee. Candidates should produce Original Certificate and Documents for verification at the time of interview.

14. ANTI – RAGGING

Ragging means doing of any act, by disorderly conduct, to a student of an educational institution, which causes or is likely to causes physical or fear or shame or embarrassment to that student and includes.

- i) Teasing, abusing or paying practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students ; or
- ii) Asking student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course willingly, to do.

All institutions will have to abide by the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India. Dated May 16, 200 is SLP No. (S) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs. Council Principal's Colleges, Kearala & Ors. (with SLP © No. 14356 / 2005) and the recommendations approved by the Honourable Supreme Court of India on effective prevention of ragging in educational Institutions.

Incase the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later he / she shall be expelled for the educational institutions.

Each of the student of the institution and his / her parent or guardian are required to submit a combined, undertaking at the time of registration / admission in prescribed format available in Annexure II which is mandatory for registration / admission.

15. Hostel facility will be provided to candidates, if required.

16. Students are liable to undergo GNM course and its syllabus as stipulated by Indian Nursing Council.

17. FEE STRUCTURE :

18. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES :

- a) Levying amount towards liquidated damages from candidates discontinuing their studies.
- b) **For GNM Candidates** : If any candidate discontinues studies after the cut-off date for closure of admissions fixed by the Government, he/she shall be liable to pay a liquidated damage of Rs 50,000 (Rupees Fifty Thousand only), along with the amount received as stipend, allowances, etc.,. Any other liabilities, if applicable, shall also be payable. In all such cases original certificates of SSLC / Plus Two and Transfer Certificate will be returned/issued only after the remittance of liquidated damages to the authority concerned.
